Dear Madam and Sirs

According to the guidelines 2011/65/EU (ROHS II) and 2012/19/EU (WEEE) a prohibition for new electronically devices being put into circulation became effective on July 1st 2006.

We do use control systems, drives etc. to manufacture our machines. We purchase these devices from well-known producers and don't produce them ourselves.

Due to CE – label we determine the legal regulations for our machines and we do also document this in our declaration of conformity.

We do assure you that we take all action needed due to our quality and environmental Management.

Since the implementation of the guidelines we do require the same from our suppliers and therefore we can assure you the compliance with regulations.
